100: Oils, Acrylics

200: Watercolor, Gouache

300: Pastels, Colored Pencils

400: Pen & Ink, Charcoal, Graphite, Conté

500: 3-D, Printmaking

Mixed media will be listed in predominate media

Entry Guidelines

All entries must be the original work of the artist and may not be more than two years old. *No instructor assistance or patterns*

Maximum size 32 X 40. *If larger, entrant must supply easel for display*

2-D works must be properly framed and wired for hanging. *No saw-tooth hangers, clip frames or damaged frames.* Wrapped canvas okay.

Prints must be hand pulled by the artist
No mechanical or digital reproductions.

All work must remain for the duration of the show. Work must not have been in a previous SWA show.

While every precaution will be taken by those handling the show, SWA will not be responsible for loss or damage to the art works.

Reception & Award Presentation

The reception and awards ceremony will be on Sunday, May 16th at 1:PM. To 3:PM. The awards will be presented at 2:PM and all art work must be picked up from 3 to 4:PM.

Judge: Aimee Erickson

Popular artist, illustrator and art instructor from the Portland area with a BFA from Brigham Young University, Ms. Erickson has the experience and background to be an excellent judge for the SWA show.

Note

This is a juried exhibition and the judge may decline pieces if the available show space cannot accommodate all entries. Artists whose work is not accepted may pick up their pieces by twelve noon on Thursday, May 13, 2010.
